

## Render the Tender

*Some Pharisees and Herodians came to Jesus and asked, “Is it lawful to pay taxes to Caesar, or not?” Jesus said, “Why put me to the test? Bring me a coin.” They brought one. Then he said, “Whose head is this, and whose title?” They answered, “Caesar’s.” Jesus said, “Give to Caesar what is Caesar’s and give to God what belongs to God.” - Mark 12:13-17*

Property disputes are well-known to children.

I witnessed many on the playgrounds of yesteryear. Child A takes Child B's ball. Child B exclaims, "Hey, that's mine!" Child A replies, "Really? I don't see your name on it!" Some parents sharpie their children's names on everything from basketballs to briefs for this very reason.

Roman coins in Jesus' day took it a few steps further. They not only bore Caesar's name but also his picture. Because those coins were clearly Caesar's, Jesus logically says, "Give to Caesar what is Caesar's."

What Jesus says next—"Give to God what belongs to God"—is less obvious, but the same principle applies. What belongs to God? That which bears God's name and image. What bears God's image? We do. We are God's children, God's currency in this world.

It's been said that our life is God's gift to us and what we do with our life is our gift back to God. I would take it a step further. My life is not mine at all. My life belongs to God. My life is God.

I don't live that awareness in every moment or even in most moments. Fortunately, deep belonging to God doesn't need our awareness. God's name is on us regardless.



## Connection

...God is still speaking,

A Letter from Conference Minister Bonnie Bates

*"I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race,  
I have kept the faith."  
(2 Timothy 4:7)*

Many of you know that my personal life has been in a state of some upset in the last months. Due to health reasons, my husband has relocated to North Carolina to live with our son, daughter-in-law, and

grandchildren so he has more daily care. As a result, I moved to a smaller apartment on September 1.

My husband had heart surgery on October 8<sup>th</sup>. Because that surgery was unsuccessful, he has another heart surgery scheduled on October 29<sup>th</sup>. Additionally, my brother has been struggling with metastatic brain cancer and is in the last stages of life. Balancing these family health issues and the work I am called to do has been challenging.

I cannot begin to tell you how much I have been supported by the staff and members of the Conference. The staff has been pitching in to cover some activities. I have been doing some work off-site and via Zoom so I have been able to continue fulfilling my job responsibilities. The pastors of the conference and our congregations have been lifting prayers for my family and me. I know that the prayers of support are helping me to *"fight the good fight"* and *"keep the faith."*

Human life throws us curveballs. My husband was seeing a cardiologist here in Pennsylvania so his heart and health issues are unexpected. I would have expected my brother to outlive me since he is three years my junior. Yet in the midst of all this, I have never felt alone; never felt unsupported. I have never felt God was not walking with me. I have continued to *"fight"* through the difficulties in my life hand-in-hand with those who are *"racing in this life"* with me. For *"the Lord has stood by me and given me strength"* (2 Timothy 4:17).

I want you all to know that **YOU** are also my strength. As we come together as a Conference on November 2, and we learn, conduct business, and worship, please know the gratitude I feel for each one of you. We have accomplished a lot together.

- Established two Conference Meetings each year with different agendas


You have done this work in the race we run together. Thank you. Feel good about the way you have supported one another as we continue to be the people of God serving in the Penn Northeast Conference.
